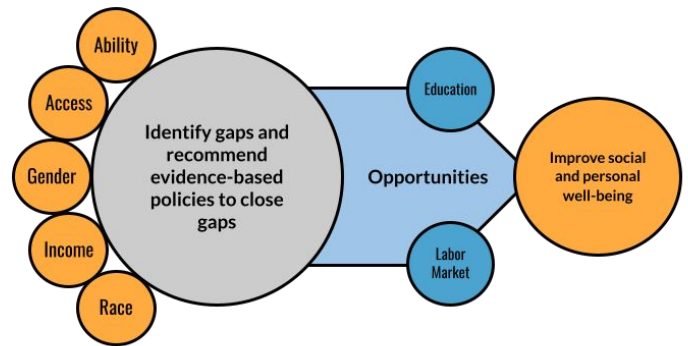
GAP ANALYSIS AND POLICY SOLUTIONS
